Binche Whut'en Land Code is important because it allows the First Nation to reclaim full control over reserve lands and resources, replacing about 44 restrictive Indian Act sections with community-developed laws that reflect Dakelh values and support economic, environmental, and cultural sustainability.

Key reasons include:

- Self-determination and governance: It affirms the inherent right to manage lands independently, shifting authority from federal bureaucracy to the Nation for transparent, member-accountable decisions on land use, possession, and development.
- Economic development: Streamlined processes remove federal approval delays, enabling faster leasing, investment attraction, job creation, and business growth on reserve.
- Cultural and environmental protection: The Code embeds traditional Dakelh principles into land laws, mandates an environmental regime, ensures conservation, and prevents expropriation to preserve heritage for future generations.
